DECLARAÇÃO	CONFIRMAÇÃO
POSITIVA	NEGATIVA
NEGATIVA	POSITIVA



QUESTION TAG = Verbo Auxiliar ( + ou - ) + Sujeito Pronominal



## SUJEITO PRONOMINAL

**I** = EU  
**YOU** = TU/VOCE<sup>Ê</sup>  
**HE** = ELE  
**SHE** = ELA  
**IT** = ELE(A)  
**WE** = NOS  
**YOU** = VÓS/VOCE<sup>Ê</sup>S  
**THEY** = ELES(AS)
